#### **Ag Ambassador Mission**

#### **Membership Requirements**

- The student's declared primary major must be in the College of Agriculture & Natural Resources (students with concurrent majors are eligible).
- The student must be a full-time student as defined by the University of Wyoming, and have attended the College of Agriculture & Natural Resources for at least one full semester.
   Freshman and transfer students may apply for membership during their second and subsequent semesters.
- Undergraduate students must have and maintain a minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA and graduate students must have and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Ambassadors must demonstrate a commitment to furthering their knowledge of the College of Agriculture & Natural Resources and the University of Wyoming through their participation in Ag Ambassador activities.

#### **Expectations**

The University of Wyoming, College of Agriculture & Natural Resources Student Ambassador Organization is a select group of students charged by the Dean to promote the College of Agriculture & Natural Resources in various ways, to both external and internal audiences. Ag Ambassadors help promote the College of Agriculture & Natural Resources and the agriculture industry in various ways. Activities include, but are not limited to:

- Prospective student recruitment
- Retention of current students
- Acting as liaisons with the general public
- Participate in alumni and donor relation activities
- Share student experiences with diverse audiences
- Participate in leadership classes and/or conferences

- Submit the attached application form and a copy of your resume by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 30, 2016. Your resume should include academic achievements, community service, campus activities, and leadership experience.
- Applicants will be interviewed by a panel as a part of the selection process. You will be

  the College of Agriculture & Natural Resources. Students should prepare appropriately before
  interviewing with the selection committee.
