There are no direct benefits to you in this research project. The results of this study, however, will increase our knowledge of the 4-H club meetings, events, and/or activities. This knowledge will potentially enhance the program offered for you. You are free to decide whether or not you will participate in this research project. You may also stop anytime in which that it makes you feel uncomfortable without negatively affecting your relationship with your leaders, fellow 4-H youth, or mentors. Your decision will not result in any loss of benefits that you have or are entitled to.
