**Volunteer (V)** - experiences in which you have participated, such as performing at 4-H activities, camps, achievement programs, workshops, judging events, directing community tours, field trips, fairs, and others.

**Elected (E)** - 4-H offices you have held.

**Appointed (A)** - committees on which you have served.

**Promotional (P)** - what you have done to promote 4-H, such as presentations to organizations, radio and/or television appearances, participation in parades, etc.

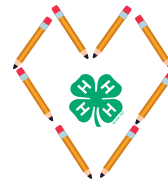
