Qualifications:

- ~Must be enrolled as a Leader on wy.4honline.com
- ~Must have completed the leader orientation training
- ~Passed the background screening and Motor Vehicle Check
- ~Attend the Mandatory Chaperone Training at camp
- ~Desire and ability to work with teenagers and children

Specific Tasks:

- ~Assure campers are properly supervised
- ~Assist in the direction, supervision and organization of campers in their cabins, activities and throughout camp
- ~Lead or assist with day sessions and evening program activities
- ~Help inspire and lead groups through activities
- ~Participate enthusiastically in program activities
- ~Ensure campers follow personal health and hygiene
- ~Assisting youth as caregiver, helping them with social conflicts, homesickness, etc.
- ~Set a good example for campers and others regarding general camp procedures
- ~Be a role model to campers with a positive attitude and behavior
- ~Follow, uphold and maintain standards of safety consistent with University of Wyoming risk management procedures
