TREASURER'S REPORT: Carrie reported on the council lines. Transfers to budgeted lines were made, the two leaders accounts still need to be merged.

KIM & CELESTE: The Extension Office is now open to the public. On May 15th, the University order will expire. Because of the virus, some funds have been refunded- Summer Day Camp, project week, etc on a case-by-case basis. The Youth Livestock Sale "meetings" are happening, members need fill out paperwork by May 15. Summer Interns will begin May 18. The GAMB meeting space is still closed, meaning some meetings will be cancelled or rescheduled like Leader Orientation. Horse progress shows and rodeos will begin at the end of Rabbit IDs are due June 1. Enrollment for members to participate in summer activities are due June 1. Sewing Conference will be the beginning of June with pattern approval by appointment. Shooting Sport shirts are due June 3. Volunteer Jean Gorman will teach a paper piecing quilting heart class. Waiting to see if Summer Day Camp will be able to happen June 1. Jackpot will be June 12. The University gave every county \$2900 to purchase programming expenses, a serger and robots will be purchased.
