



<u>SECRETARY'S REPORT</u>: Jody moved to approve the minutes as printed, Kristi second it, and motion passes.

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT:</u> Carrie reported that the council has \$28,177.82 in the checking account. Kennidee moved to approve the treasurers report, Landon second it, and motion passes.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u>: We need to find a wagon for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade for Master Gardeners. We are donating one to be pulled in the parade. The County Shoot deadline is May 14<sup>th</sup> by 5 pm for County Shoot on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, & 13<sup>th</sup>.

<u>SPECIAL REQUESTS</u>: The Robotics group would like to do some fundraising with baskets and raffle tickets in the future; specifics not quite finalized. Funds are needed to raise \$1000-\$1500 for extra brains to have a decent class. Clover Express reported that they made \$124.00 in March for the Hunter Safety Class meals and \$300.39 at the Jackpot Shoot concessions. Clover Express also requested to be allowed to do the concessions on June 12<sup>th</sup> for County Shoot.

<u>KIM & CELESTE:</u> Kim reported that the Children's Festival is May 15<sup>th</sup> and looking for help in concessions. The Sewing Conference is June 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>; registration is May 18<sup>th</sup>; and cutting is May 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>. Summer Day Camp is full already this year at Buffalo Ridge. Showcase Showdown is June 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>. State Shoot is July 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> with the sign-up deadline of June 13<sup>th</sup>. Youth Livestock Meetings are happening this month and are mandatory; make sure to get to one if you are taking an animal. Ownership for animals besides beef is June 1<sup>st</sup> and taggings are due by June 15<sup>th</sup>. The Livestock Committee has an event on May 15<sup>th</sup> and showmanship clinics in July; please register for them is you are wanting to go. 4-H Camp entries are now open and due by June 1<sup>st</sup>, with counselor ones due May 14<sup>th</sup>.
