




#### Meet Our New Faces at the Office!







#### **Grandma's Molasses Cookies**

Makes 3 1/2 to 4 dozen

2 1/4 cup all-purpose flour

tsp. baking soda

1/4 tsp. (generous) salt

1 tsp. cinnamon

1 tsp. ginger

1/2 tsp. cloves

3/4 cup shortening, at room temperature (Crisco)

1 cup (packed) light brown sugar 1 large egg, at room temperature

1/4 cup molasses, preferably Grandma's (not blackstrap)

1/4 cup granulated sugar

In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, ginger and cloves. Set aside. In the bowl of an electric mixer, beat the shortening, brown sugar, egg and molasses on medium high speed until combined. Add the flour mixture and beat on lowest speed to moisten. Increase speed to medium and beat until combined, scraping down bowl as needed. Chill dough in freezer for about an hour or in the refrigerator for at least 2 hours.

Preheat oven to 375 and line baking sheets with parchment paper or lightly greased cookie sheet. Place 1/4 cup sugar in a shallow bowl. Scoop dough by rounded tablespoons and roll between your palms into 1 1/4 to 1 1/2-inch balls. Dip tops of balls in sugar and place on baking sheet about 2 1/2 inches apart

Sugar Cookies Makes 2 dozen

3 c. all-purpose flour, plus more for surface

1 tsp. baking powder

1/2 tsp. kosher salt

1 c.(2 sticks) butter, softened

1 c. granulated sugar

1 large egg

1 tsp.pure vanilla extract

1 tbsp. milk

**Buttercream Frosting** 

1 c. (2 sticks) butter, softened

5 c. powdered sugar

1/4 c. heavy cream

1/2 tsp. pure almond or lemon extract

1/4 tsp. kosher salt

Food coloring

#### **DIRECTIONS**


- 1. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, and salt and set aside.
- 2. In another large bowl, beat butter and sugar until fluffy and pale in color. Add egg, milk, and vanilla and beat until combined, then add flour mixture gradually until totally combined.
  - 3. Shape into a disk and wrap in plastic. Refrigerate 1 hour.
- 4. When ready to roll, preheat oven to 350° and line two baking sheets with parchment paper. Lightly flour a clean work surface and roll out dough until 1/8" thick. Cut out shapes and transfer to prepared baking sheets. Freeze 10 minutes (so your shapes hold while baking!).
- 5. Meanwhile, make frosting: In a large bowl using a hand mixer, beat butter until smooth, then add powdered sugar and beat until no lumps remain. Add cream, almond extract, and salt and beat until combined.
  - 6. Bake cookies until edges are lightly golden, 8 to 10 minutes.
  - 7. Let cool, then frost and decorate as desired.



- Fill in the required fields (you can use your same email and password from 4HOnline).






- Create a pin number (we recommend an easy to remember four-digit number, like the last four numbers of your phone number).
