# If you need assistance logging your hours, let me know! I am here to help you!

To earn the Master Gardener Volunteer certificate requires 40 hours of volunteer service. The timeline to get those 40 hours is very flexible, but generally 1-2 years is acceptable. There is no requirement for continuing education prior to completing the 40 volunteer hours. Following the completion of 40 volunteer hours there is a requirement of 10 continuing education hours and 20 volunteer hours per year to remain an Active Master Gardener.

# Here is a quick way to report your volunteer hours! Using your smartphone, follow the directions below.



- 1. Open the camera app on your smartphone.
- 2. Focus the camera on the QR code, you might have to gently tap the code. You also might have move your phone around until it "picks up" the QR code.
- 3. Follow the instructions on the screen to complete the action. It might ask if you want to open "uwyoextension.org" in Safari.
- 4. Tap on that link and you are to the reporting link.
