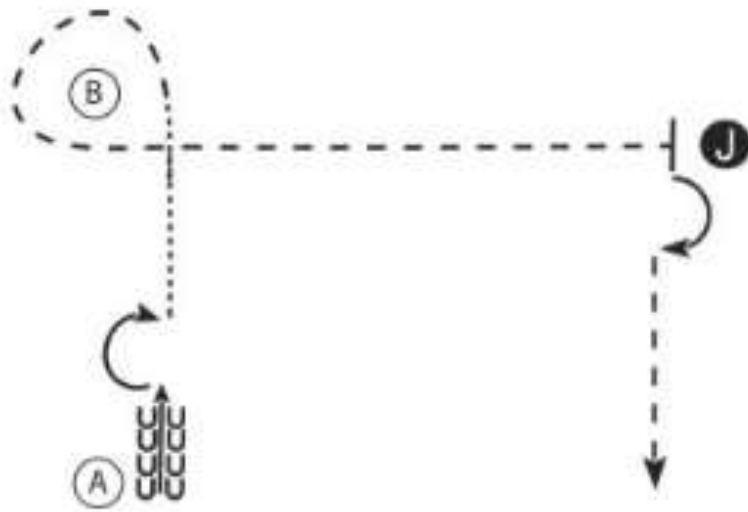
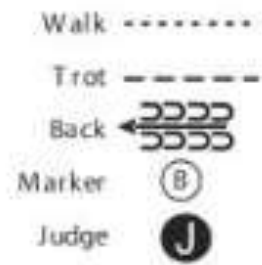


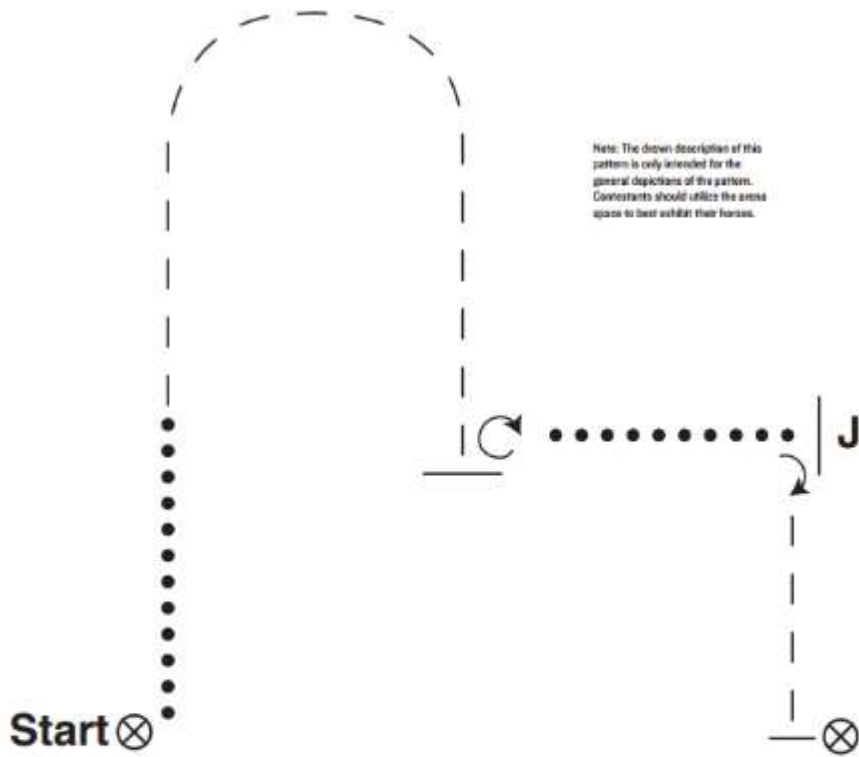
SHOWMANSHIP – OVERALL



1. At A back 4 steps
2. Perform a 180 degree turn
3. Walk to B
4. At B trot around B and to the judge, set up for inspection
5. When dismissed perform a 90 degree turn and trot straight away from the judge

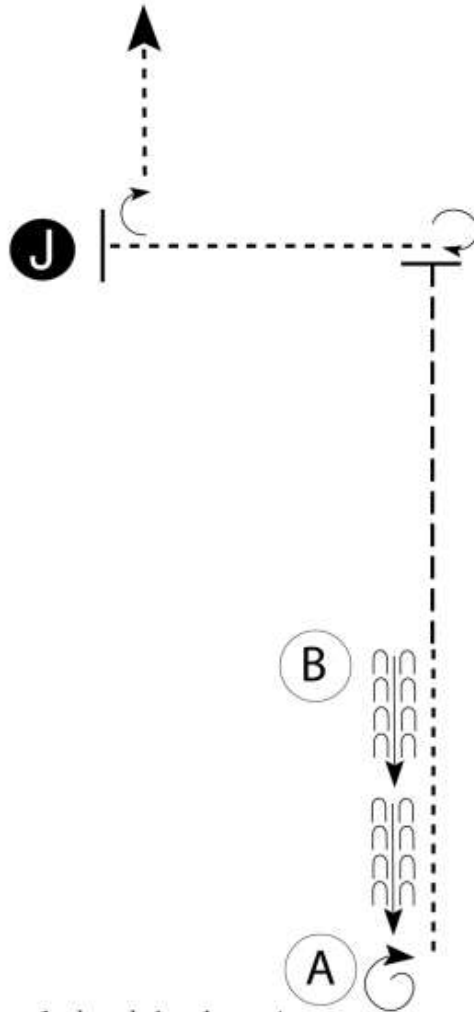


SHOWMANSHIP – FFA



1. Walk $\frac{1}{2}$ line
2. Trot around end and down line
3. Halt and execute a $\frac{1}{4}$ turn
4. Walk to judge
5. Set up for inspection
6. After inspection, $\frac{1}{4}$ turn and trot to marker
7. Exit at a walk or trot

SHOWMANSHIP – Senior




Be ready at B.

1. When acknowledged, back to A.
2. Perform a 360 degree turn.
3. Walk to B.
4. Trot until even with judge and stop.
5. Perform a 270 degree turn.
6. Walk to judge, stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn.
8. Walk straight away from judge.


SHOWMANSHIP –Intermediate



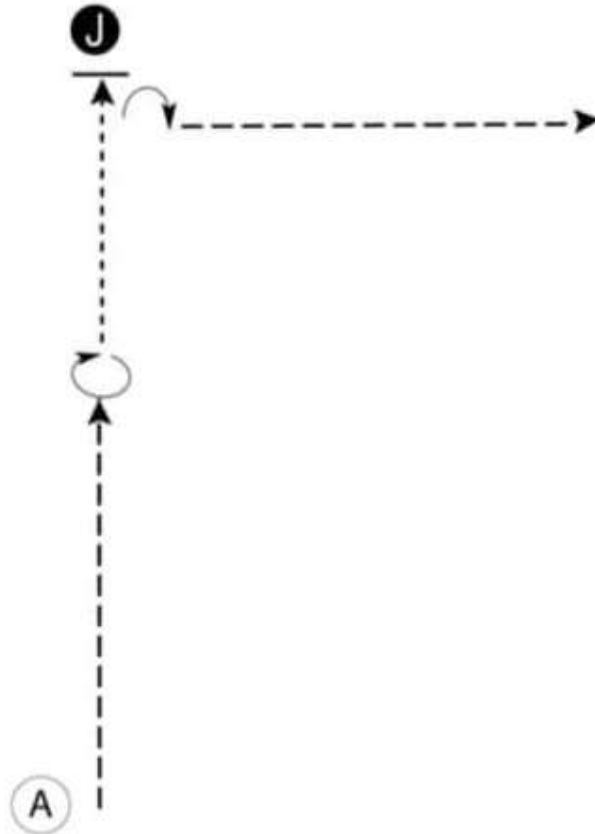
Be ready at A.

1. Trot from A to B.
2. Stop at B and pivot 180 degrees.
3. Back to C.
4. Turn 180 degrees and walk to judge.
5. Stop and set up for inspection.
6. When dismissed, turn 90 degrees and trot away.

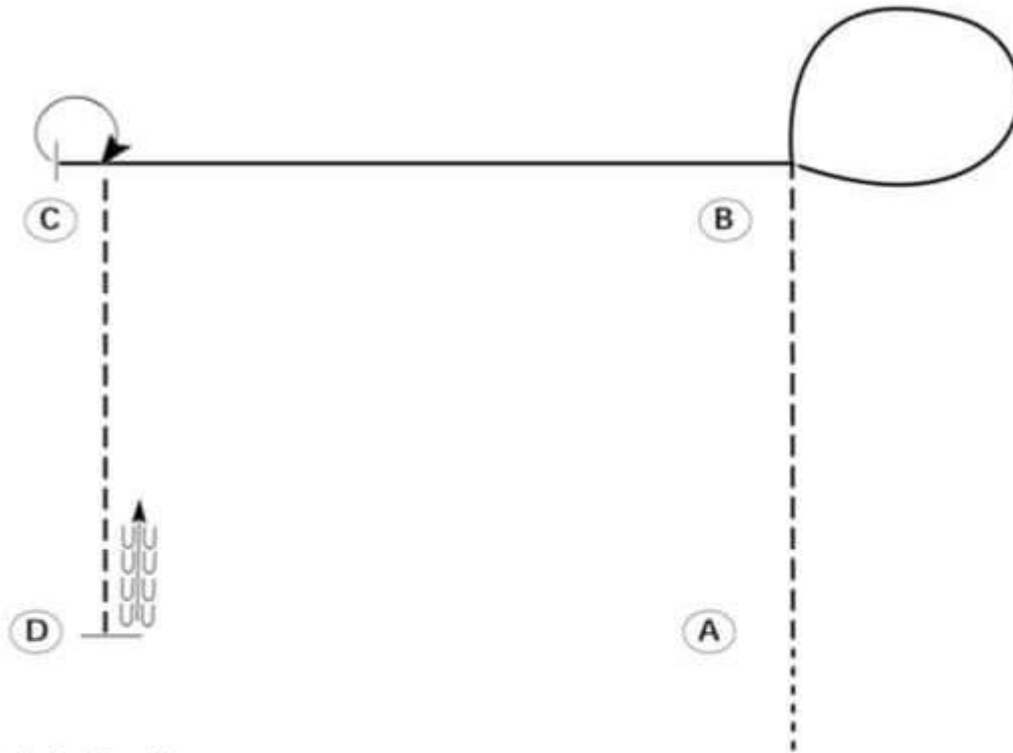
Showmanship- Junior

3. Perform a 360 degree turn.

Western Horsemanship – Junior



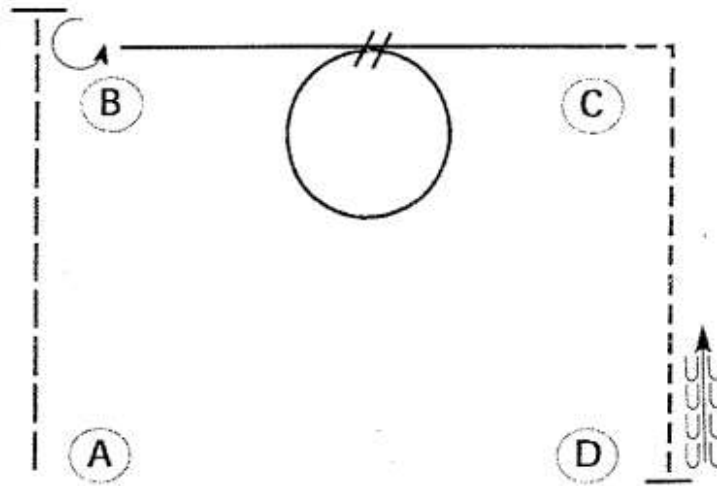
Be ready before A.

1. Walk to A.
2. Jog to B.
3. Lope on the right lead in a circle to the right.
4. Continue to lope on the right lead to C.
5. Stop at C.
6. Turn 270 degrees to the right.
7. Jog to D.
8. Stop at D and back approximately one horse length.

Western Horsemanship – Senior & Intermediate



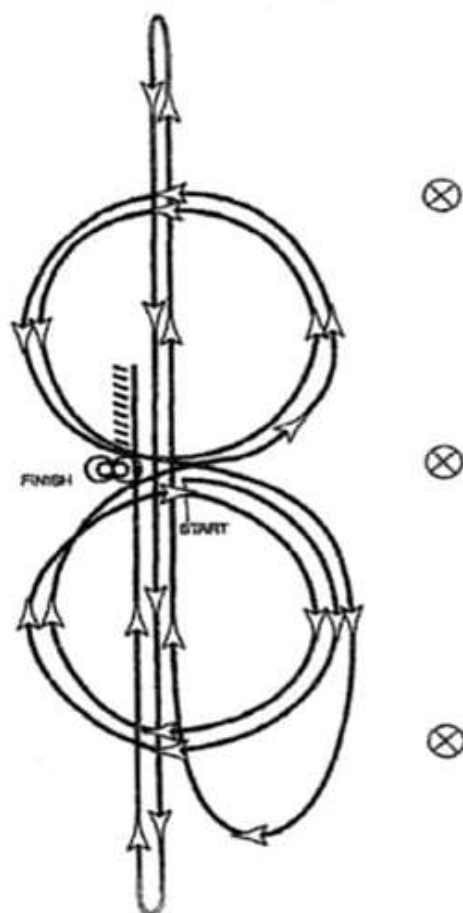
Be ready at A.

1. Extended trot from A past B.
2. Stop past B and perform a 270 degree turn to the left.
3. Lope on the left lead halfway to C.
4. Perform a simple lead change and lope a circle to the right.
5. Continue to lope to C.
6. At C, break to a jog and jog to D.
7. Stop and back approximately one horse length.

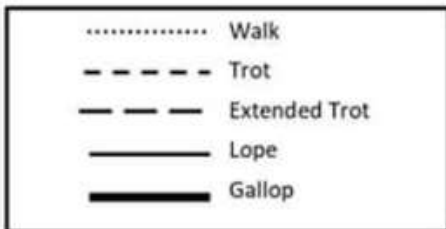
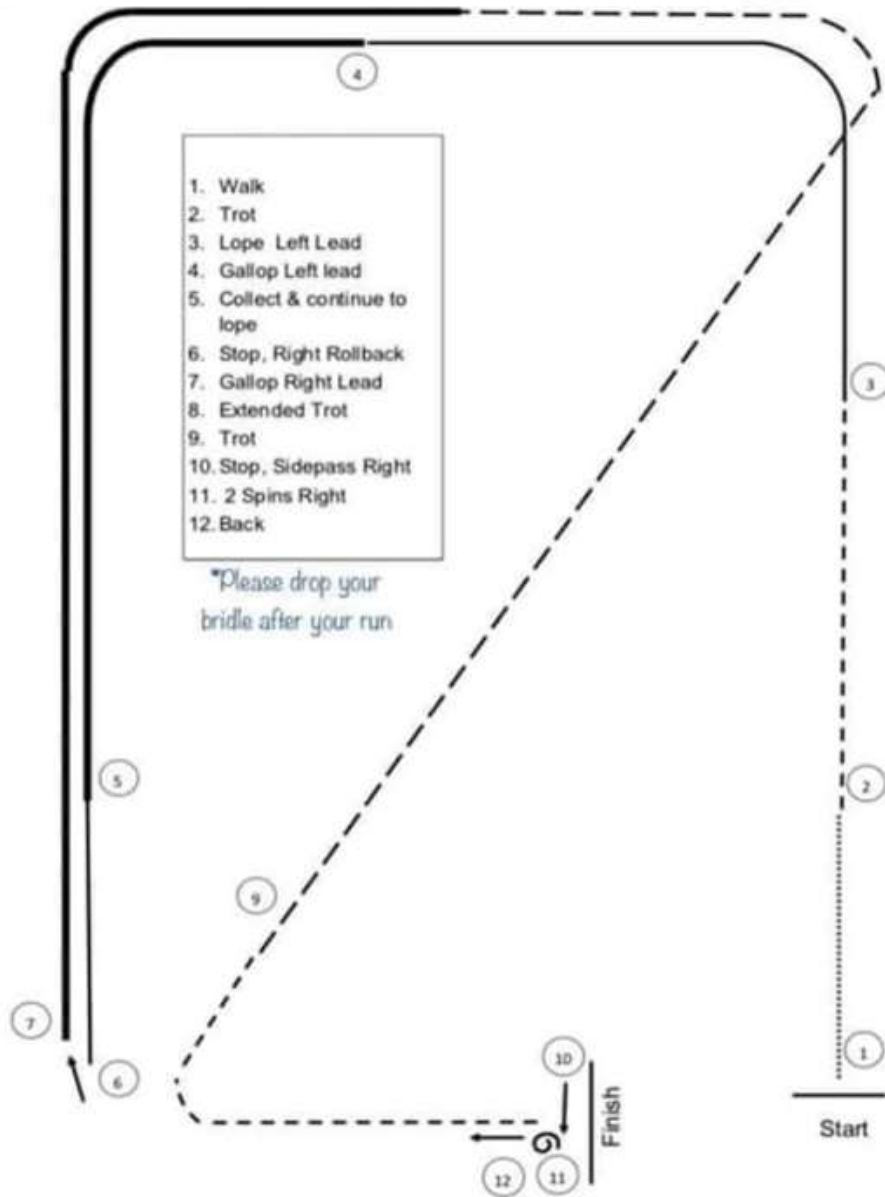

Reining – ALL



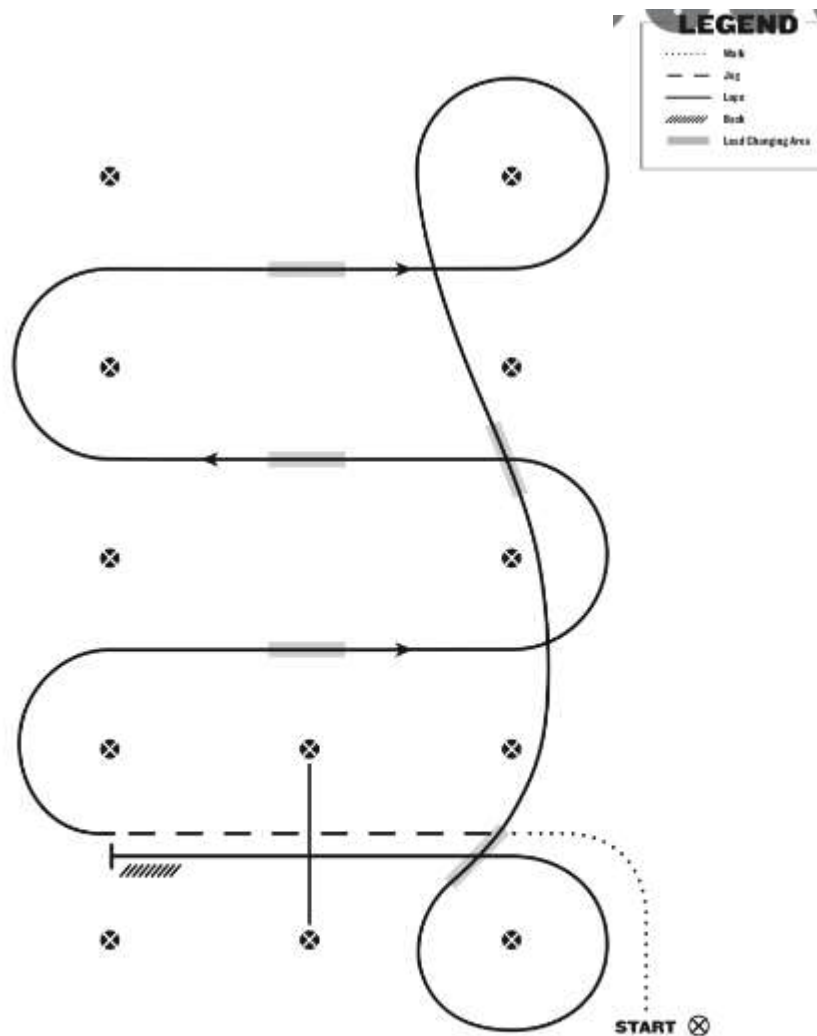
1. Beginning at the center of the arena, take a right lead and complete two circles to the right, away from the judge, of moderate size and speed.
2. At the center of the arena, change leads and do two circles to the left, both of moderate size and speed.
3. At the center of the arena, change leads.
4. Go to the end of the arena without stopping or breaking gait, and begin run down near the approximate center of the arena. Run the length of the arena past the marker.
5. Do a square, sliding stop, then hesitate.
6. Turn left and begin a run to the opposite end of the arena. Run the length of the arena past the marker.
7. Do a square, sliding stop, then hesitate
8. Turn right, and begin a rundown past the center marker of the arena.
9. Do a square, sliding stop, and back to the center of the arena or at least 10 feet. Let the horse settle in the area of the stop.
10. Do two spins to the right.
11. Do two spins to the left.
12. Hesitate to show completion of the pattern.

Ranch Riding – ALL



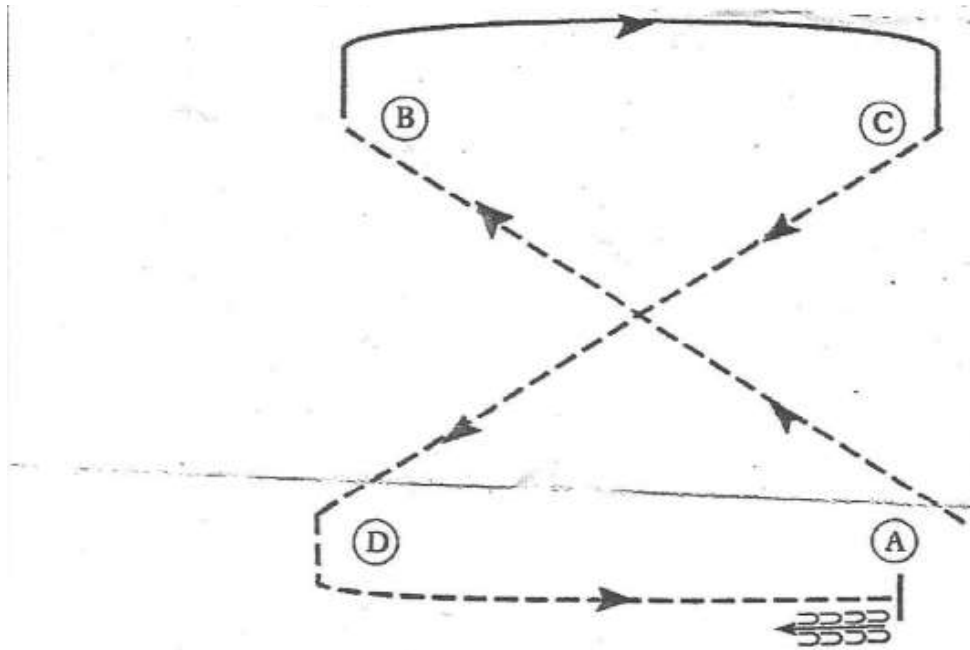
*You may film your pattern from wherever you like, as long as we can see all the maneuvers and gaits in the video. Please make sure to film landscape, or horizontally, if possible !

Western Riding – ALL



1. Walk at least 15 feet from start cone to the first marker, as drawn, transition to jog, jog over log.
2. Transition to the lope right lead
3. First crossing change
4. Second crossing change
5. Third crossing change
6. Circle & first line change
7. Second line change & circle
8. Lope over log
9. Stop & back

Hunt Seat Equitation – ALL



Be ready at A.

1. Posting trot on the left diagonal to B.
2. Canter on the right lead to and around C.
3. Posting trot on the right diagonal to D.
4. Sitting trot to A.
5. Halt at A and back approximately one horse length.

Exit at a sitting trot.
