Funds will be used towards camp. Meghan moved to approve both club's requests, Amanda second it, and motion passes.

<u>KIM & CELESTE:</u> Showcase Showdown is coming up the same week as camp; T-shirts will be coming as well. Sewing Conference deadline is May 18th. Summer Day Camp is almost full, and staff has been hired. There are only a few more shooting sports practices to get cards signed off. Summer Interns have been hired; Katie Hudson, Megan Hanson, Brianna Jafek. 4-H Camp is coming up soon and preparation is taking place. Horse Summer events are scheduled; check the newsletter for more information. Fair will be here before we know it and lots of meetings and preparation has begun for it as well.
