- O Keep Track: 4-H Record Books are a great place to keep track of all your involvement from projects to leadership and participation. Plus, when you get older, it is great to go back and read your stories to see how far you have grown.
- O Scholarships and Resumes: When it comes time to applying for scholarships or jobs, you will need to document a lot of the areas that are within your record book. So keep it up to date for an easy location to find all the information.
- O Finances: Hopefully you find a spark within 4-H and it leads to a career or source of income. Keeping track of your finances will help you to see the value of the work you do.
- O Real World: These are a great tool to keep track of your 4-H work, but did you know that it also prepares you for the real world? As 4-H Educators, Makala and I do our own "Record Books" to share with the University of Wyoming about programming that was done with Campbell County 4-H.
