The countdown to the end of the school year is on. Which means that Summer, 4-H Camp and Fair are just around the corner. How exciting!

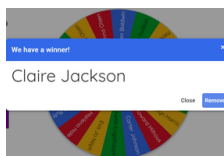
The other countdown we are doing is all the deadlines that are sneaking up on us!

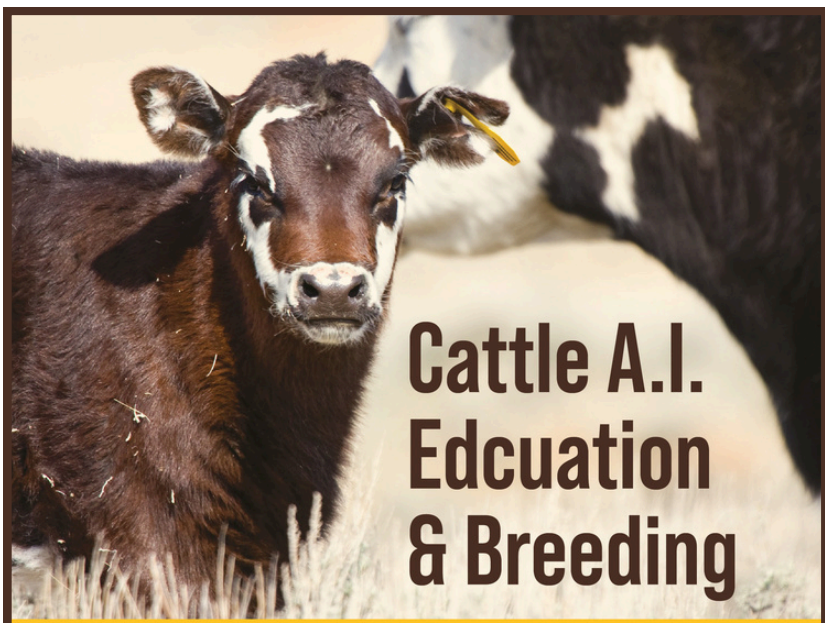


RABBIT IDS DUE JUNE 3RD!

Due by 5pm to the Extension Office

- Rabbit ID's are due to the Extension Office by 5:00pm on June 1st. All rabbits must have permanent tattoo identification numbers or letters in the left ear. (See page 91 of the Fair Book)
- You must declare that you are taking a Meat Pen on the Rabbit ID. Meat Pen rabbits can be purchased after June 1st of the current year. Meat Pen rabbits must be in the exhibitor's possession and a head shot photograph, with left ear tattoo visible, submitted to the Fair Office as of the entry deadline - July 1, 2024.
