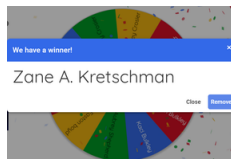
Jade Painter

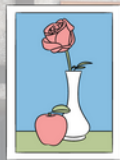

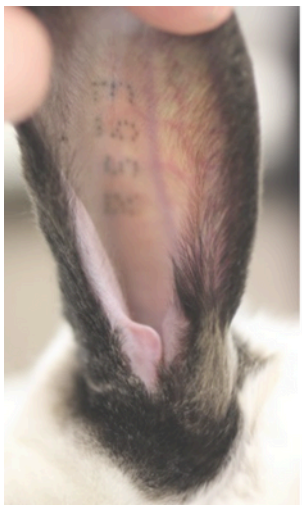
