The goal of this project is to bring 4-H visibility into our community, celebrate our local 4-H clubs and members, and recognize the important role that community businesses play in supporting youth programs.

Our Campbell County 4-H Clubs are excited to partner with you to celebrate National 4-H Week this year, October 4th-10th, 2026! During National 4-H Week, participating 4-H clubs will partner with local businesses to decorate and paint a designated storefront window with a National 4-H Week-themed design.

- A 4-H club will contact a local business and request permission to paint a window.
- Club members will work together to create and paint an appropriate, family-friendly design.
- The design may include the 4-H clover, National 4-H Week messaging, the club name, and other 4-H-related artwork.
- Clubs will coordinate with the business to determine the appropriate window, painting date, and any specific guidelines the business would like followed.
- Paint and supplies will be provided by the 4-H club unless otherwise arranged.
- Clubs will take care to protect the business property and surrounding areas while painting.
- At the conclusion of the celebration, clubs will coordinate with the business regarding removal of the artwork and will leave the window clean.

We hope this project will create a fun and visible celebration of 4-H throughout Campbell County while giving our youth an opportunity to practice communication, teamwork, creativity, responsibility, and community engagement.

Your business's participation is completely voluntary, and we appreciate your consideration and support of our local 4-H youth. By allowing a club to decorate your window, you are helping young people celebrate an organization that encourages them to learn, lead, grow, and serve their communities.
