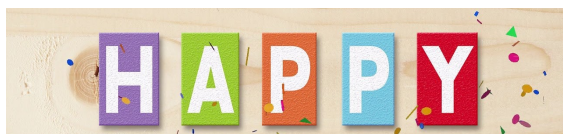
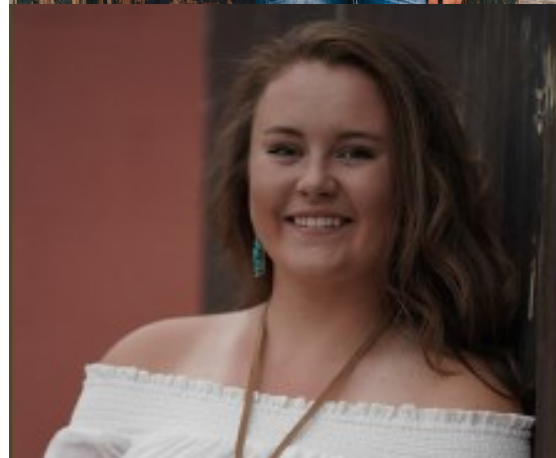

Horse ID's Due:



July 1st



Starting this 4-H year, (2018-2019) if you are in the Horse Project, these are the steps you need to follow to make sure your horse is eligible to use in 4-H events and County Fair:

1. **4HOnline:**

Enter Animal Name, Breed, Birthdate (if unknown), Description, Sex, and Owner Name along with two pictures of your horse

2. **“Wyoming 4-H Horse ID and Safety Certification” form:**

This form must be printed, filled out by you and a horse project leader who can safety certify you and your horse and then turned in to the Carbon County Extension office.

Dog

Dog ID's Due:



June 1st



For your dog to be eligible to compete in the Carbon County Fair you must turn in your dog's identification papers by June 1st. Identification papers include:

- The “Wyoming Dog ID” form (found on the Wyoming 4-H website and the Carbon County 4-H website under “Forms”)
- Updated Shot Record from your dog's veterinarian

Send both documents to the Carbon County Extension Office my mail or email by June 1st!

NOTE: If you have already turned in an ID on the dog you plan to use this year, you DO NOT need to do it again.
