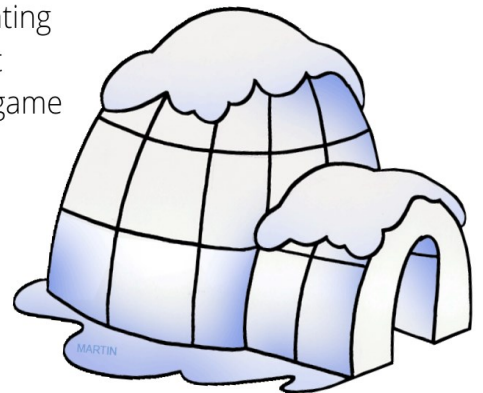

As an ambassador you would:

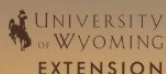
- Help with state fitting & showmanship camps.
