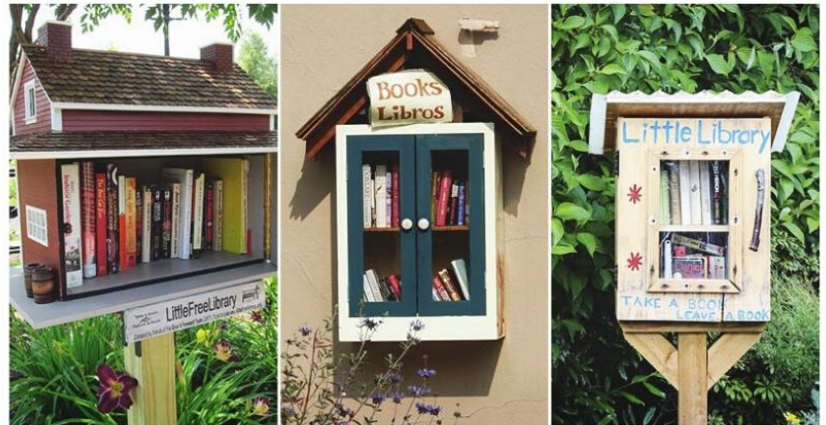
In order to encourage reading in Carbon County, the Carbon County Library Foundation (CCLF) is offering a program to help establish Free Little Libraries in the communities of our County.

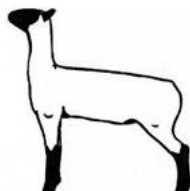

Livestock

Market Project Members - Things to keep in mind this year as you make decisions around your 4-H project animal:

- 01** Raising an animal is still a great educational experience!
- 02** You can always eat your animal
- 03** Buyers may not be able to spend as much money this year with their economical situation
- 04** There will probably be opportunities to show and sell your animal virtually!
- 05** You can still complete a market animal project without an animal-- present a poster about an aspect of raising that animal during a club meeting (virtually or in person)
- 06** We understand every family will have to make their own decision based on their ability to take on the financial risk: it is a great real world lesson for our 4-H members



Looking for something to do? YQA is a valuable tool in any young producers belt. We don't require it in Carbon County, but it can be a great asset when raising your animal and makes your animal more marketable to potential buyers!

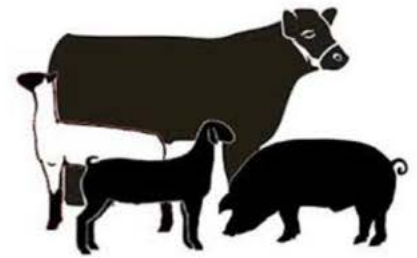
