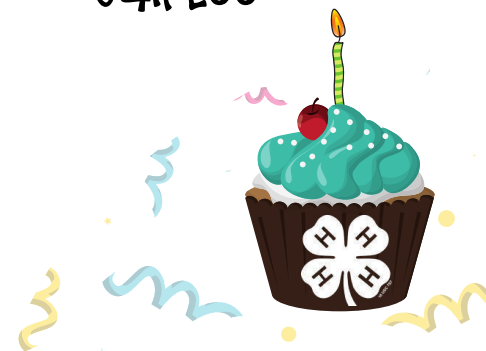
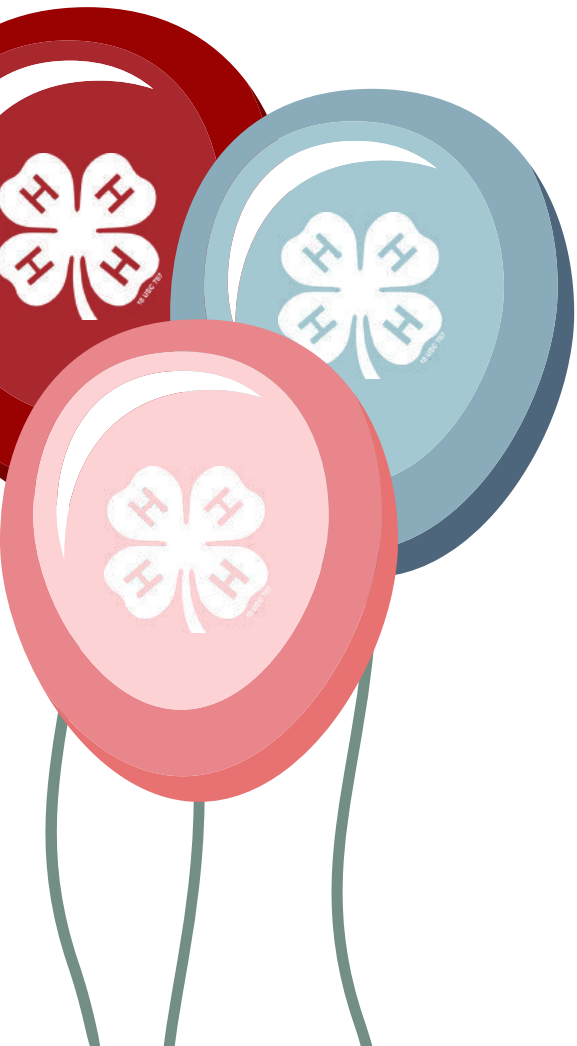

What are you planning to do?:

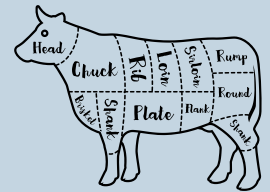
Describe your plan to accomplish your goals.

When you enroll in 4-H you pledge to the following:

Wyoming 4-H Code of Conduct

While attending 4-H meetings, projects, programs, and events as a 4-H member, I will:

- Obey all rules established by the Wyoming 4-H program, the local club/program and all local, state, and federal laws.
- Be honest and accept responsibility for personal choices.
- Conduct myself in a courteous manner and be respectful the authority of adult volunteers, youth leaders and 4-H staff, and others in leadership roles.
- Not use, accept, or carry alcohol, drugs, or tobacco, nor associate with or remain in the presence of others using the substances.
- Not carry a weapon or threaten another person with a weapon, bodily force or language.
- Not be overly affectionate or have sexual contact with another.
- Not gamble for real money.
- Not use computers or cell phones maliciously or access inappropriate websites.
- Not participate in hazing of any kind, this includes verbal, physical or cyberbullying.
- Acknowledge that searches of personal property may take place when there is reasonable suspicion of violations of law or policies.
- Be courteous and respect others as well as leaving sites and public places neat and clean.
- Not damage, tamper, misuse, or steal the property of others.
- Use appropriate language and wear acceptable clothing.
- Show kindness to others and give assistance when needed.
- Honor my commitments including fully participating in any program or event.
- Respect the individual rights, safety and property of others.

While attending overnight events as a 4-H member, I will also:

- Not leave the activity or event unless permission is secured from the adult in charge.
- Be in my sleeping area and honor established curfews.
- Not enter the sleeping areas of members of the opposite gender nor will I invite non 4-H participants to the sleeping areas.
- Be responsible for any damage caused by, or as a result of, my actions.

If I do not live up to the Code of Conduct, I know that consequences may include any or all of the following:

- Notification of my parents and appropriate staff members
- Dismissed from the 4-H event at my own expense and without any refund
- Not allowed to participate in future 4-H events
- Pay for the financial cost of damages and repairs for damage or destruction of property
- Released to the nearest law enforcement agency and/or proper authorities
- Terminate my 4-H membership in club programming

I understand that any infractions of the 4-H Code of Conduct should be reported promptly by anyone observing them to the adult in charge of the delegation and to the person in charge of the event and that she/he will advise the county and/or state office of any misconduct on my part. I have read the Code of Conduct and agree to abide by it. I understand that any infraction by me will result in any or all of the actions listed above.

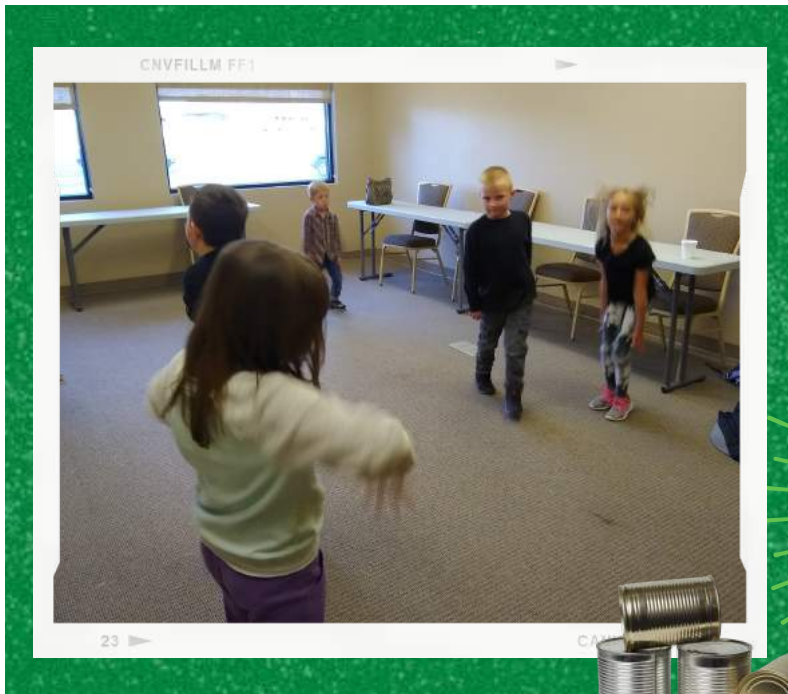

Welcome to the 2022 Rawlins 4-H Shooting Sports season!

- **4-H Registration:** Please register for your Shooting Sports discipline prior to the first practice. Register at 4h.zsuite.org.
 - Junior shooters (ages 8-10 as of Jan. 1)
 - Intermediate shooters (ages 11-13 as of Jan. 1)
 - Senior shooter (ages 14-18 as of Jan. 1)
- **Rec Center Membership:** All 4-H shooting sports shooters will need to purchase a Rec Center Shooting Range pass.
 - This pass will allow you a full year of access to the indoor and outdoor shooting range.
 - Purchase membership prior to the first practice.
 - Ask for the Nord Kirkwin Scholarship application to receive 50% off your Rec Center membership.
- **.22 Rifle and Pistol:**
 - Practices will start on Wednesday, April 6th @ the Rawlins Rec Center.
 - Practices will run from 6 to 8 each Wednesday.
 - Please contact Travis for information about equipment and practices.
- **Archery:**
 - Practices will start on Monday, April 4th @ the Rawlins Rec Center.
 - Juniors will shoot from 6 to 7.
 - Intermediate/Seniors will shoot from 7 to 8.
 - All equipment will need to be ready to use prior to the first practice. Please arrange a time to set your equipment up with Cale prior to April 4th. Text Cale for an appointment- 307-321-2644
- **Shotgun:**
 - Practices will start on Tuesday, May 3rd.
 - All shooters can come at 6 pm on that day.
 - Please contact Ryan for information about equipment and practices.

Carbon County 4-H Foundation- Stallion Service Auction Scholarship – Due April 1st, 2022

- Any senior 4-H member (age 14-18 as of Jan 1st of current year) enrolled in Carbon County school
- who is or has been enrolled in the Carbon County horse program is eligible.
- This scholarship is to any college, university, or trade school of the recipient's choice.

Carbon County Stock Grower's Association Scholarship – Due April 1st, 2022

- All applicants must have graduated (or equivalent) from a Carbon County high school.

- Open to: A) Any student enrolled in a field of agriculture - and/or B) Immediate relatives of paid Carbon County Stock Grower members (to included sons, daughters, and grandchildren) wishing to study any field.

Carbon County Farm Bureau Scholarship #1– Due April 15th, 2022

- Must be graduating from a Carbon County High School.
- Minimum 3.0 GPA, based on a 4.0 system.
- Attend a Wyoming College/University in the upcoming fall semester.
- Application and Essay must be handwritten, all question answered, and signatures signed.
- Failure to follow application requirements will result in disqualification.

Carbon County Farm Bureau “Member” Scholarship #2 – Due April 15th, 2022

- Provide parent's Carbon County Farm Bureau Membership Number
- Be a graduating senior from high school
- Have at least a 3.00 cumulative grade point average, based on a 4.00 system. (Principal must sign to verify cumulative GPA)
- Attend an accredited college, university, or trade school
- Application and Essay must be handwritten, all question answered, and signatures signed.
- Failure to follow application requirements will result in disqualification.

Carbon County Commissioners Scholarships: - Due Last Friday in April (29th), 2022

- Available to Students who plan on attending the University of Wyoming or any Wyoming Community College.
- Is not specific to graduating high school students. Non-traditional students are eligible.
- Must be a resident of Carbon County
- There will be 3 new scholarships and 1 renewal scholarship awarded each year.
