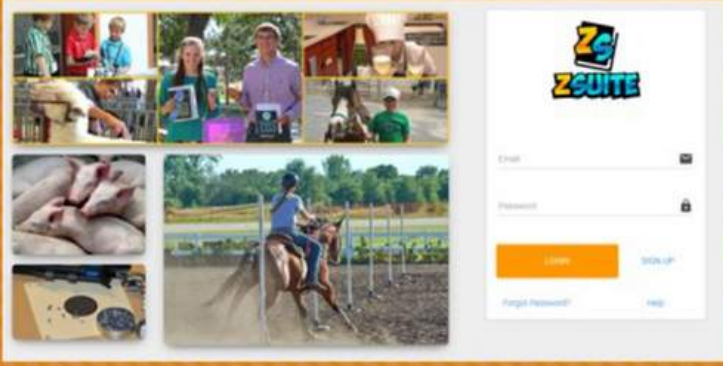

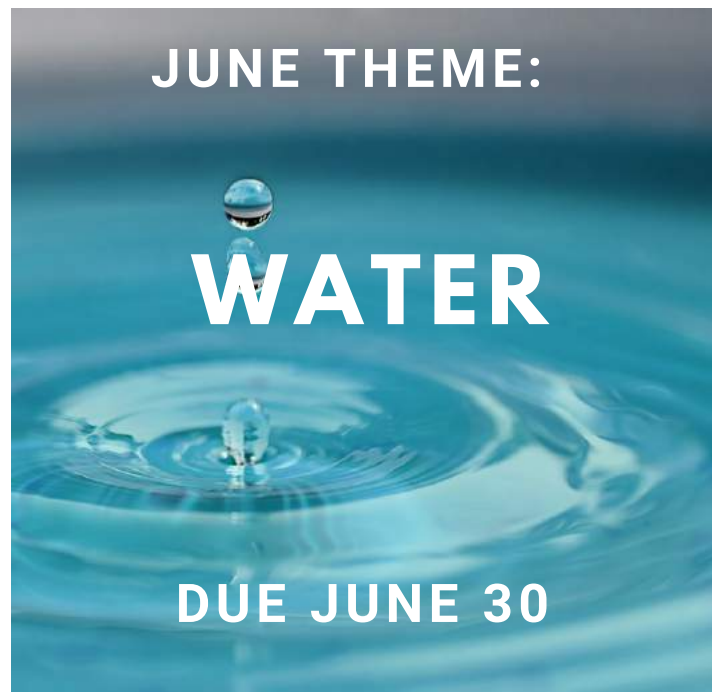

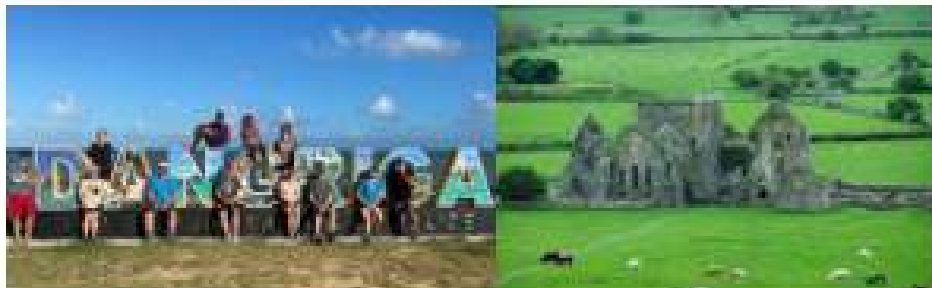

Exchange Program Overview

Come explore the world with us! You can experience the rich history and culture of Belize or Ireland. The International 4-H Exchange Program is designed to advance cultural understanding, spark an interest in learning about other cultures, and develop skills and abilities to live and work effectively in a global society.

Belize will be an outbound trip focusing on exploring the history and culture of Belize. A short host family stay is being planned. The trip will be approximately 7 days Dec. 27 – Jan 3.

Ireland will be an outbound trip focused on exploring agriculture and livestock production in Ireland. The trip will be 10 days, July 9-18.

Selection Criteria?

The program is open to senior aged 4-H members (14-19) interested in traveling internationally and learning about different cultures. Students will be selected on the following criteria:

- Personal leadership skills
- Social skills - Openness and flexibility
- Interest in learning about different cultures and global issues

How much does it cost?

Belize - \$1,750 per person.

Ireland - \$4,150 per person.

The following expenses will be included in the trip cost:

- Roundtrip airfare to host country
- Meals and lodging
- In country logistics (i.e. transportation, etc.)
- Travel insurance, Accident and sickness protection.

A \$500 deposit will be required upon selection, the remaining balance can be made in monthly payments.

Scholarships for 4-H members are available. Please contact for more information.

There will be some additional expenses for participants which include:

- Passport & passport photos
- Immunization fees (if required)
- Transportation to and from US outbound/inbound airport
- Spending money for souvenirs and in-country purchases

Wyoming Emergency Poultry Rule Due to Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza

To decrease potential spread of the disease, the Wyoming Livestock Board (WLSB) has passed an emergency rule limiting poultry movement. The emergency poultry rule was signed into effect by Governor Mark Gordon on Tuesday, 4/19. All poultry events, including exhibitions, swaps, tours, sales, and competitions, are prohibited.

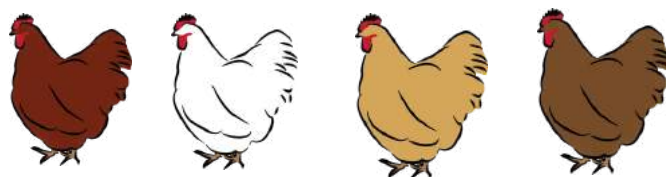
The prohibition does not include catalog or retail sale of poultry. Wyoming's emergency poultry rule may be in effect for up to 120 days. The WLSB will review the rule in late May to determine if it is still needed. Following review, further guidance regarding the emergency rule will be provided.

TO DO

Anyone involved with poultry production from the small backyard chicken owner to the large commercial producer should review their biosecurity activities to assure the health of their birds. Find guidance on biosecurity, along with recently confirmed locations, on the USDA APHIS website, <https://www.aphis.usda.gov/aphis/ourfocus/animalhealth/animal-disease-information/avian/avian-influenza/2022-hpai>

REPORTING

Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a highly contagious viral disease that can infect chickens, turkeys and other birds and can cause severe illness and/or sudden death in infected birds. Attentively monitor your birds for symptoms of HPAI which include: coughing, sneezing, nasal discharge, and other signs of respiratory distress; lack of energy and appetite; decreased water consumption; decreased egg production and/or soft-shelled, misshapen eggs; in coordination; and diarrhea. Avian influenza can also cause sudden death in birds even if they aren't showing other symptoms. If these symptoms are observed in your birds, immediately contact your veterinarian. If you don't have a regular veterinarian, contact WLSB, 307.777.8270 or 307.777.6440.

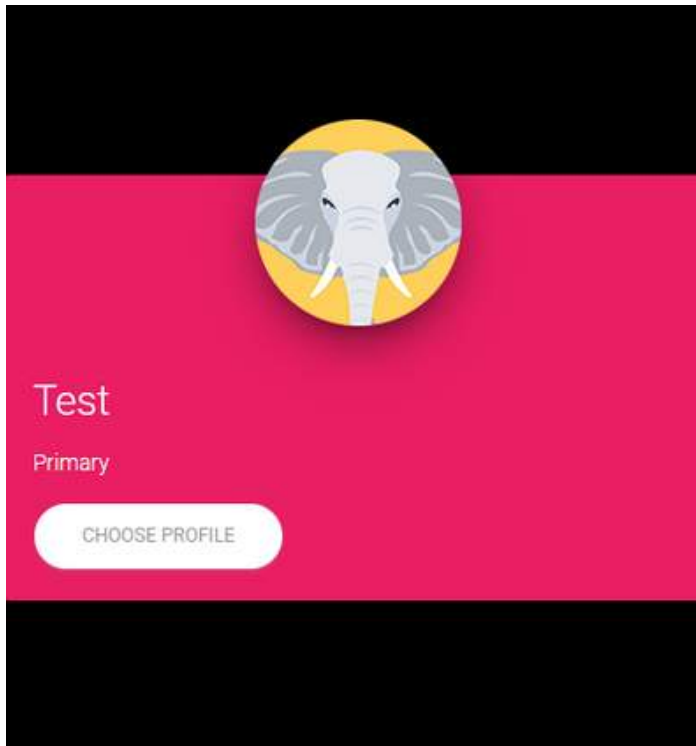

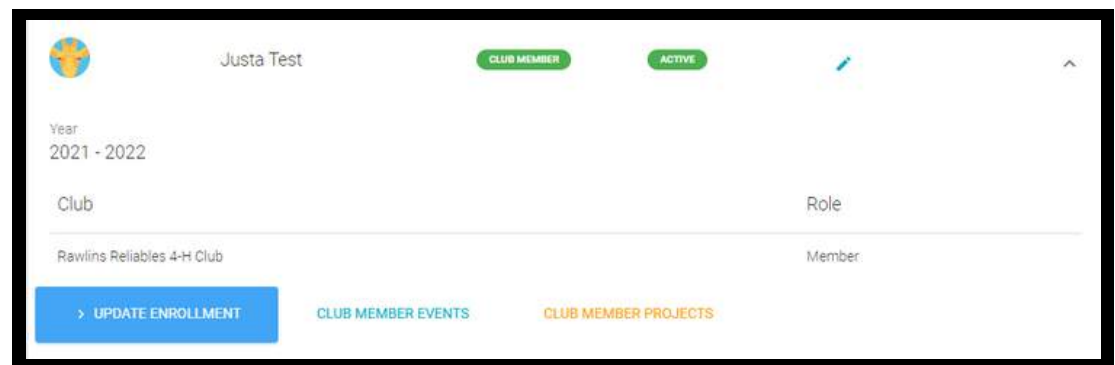

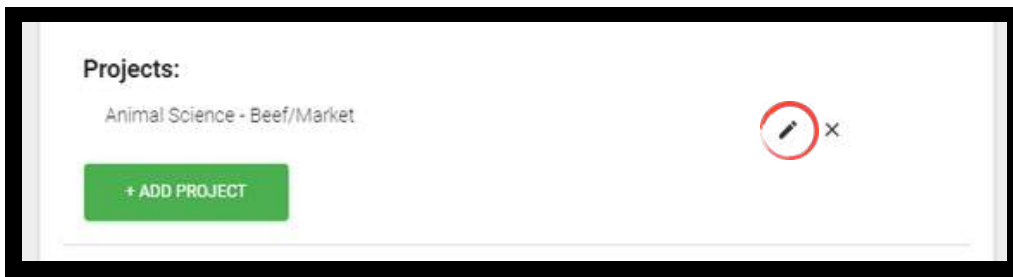
