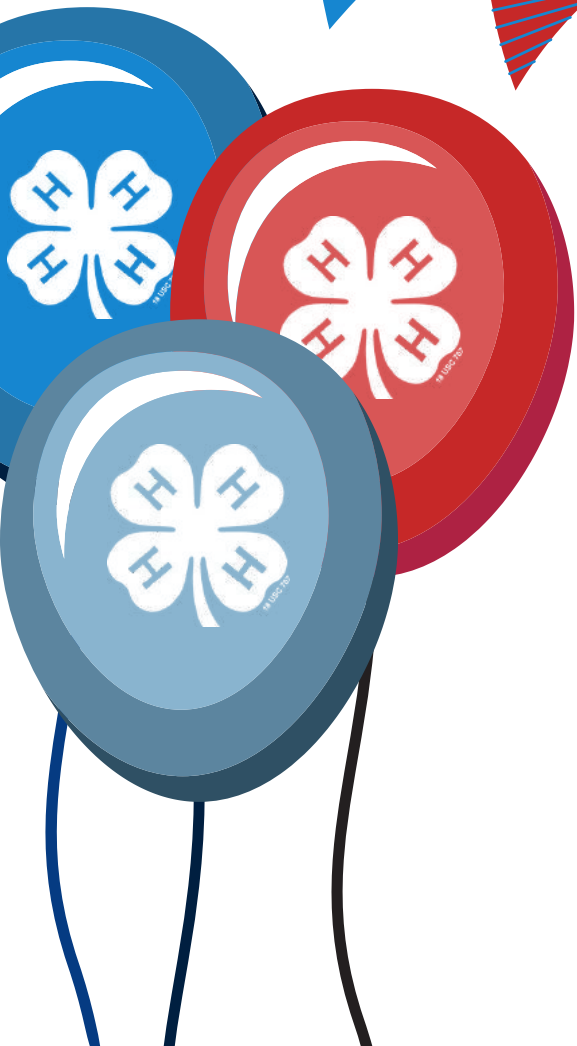

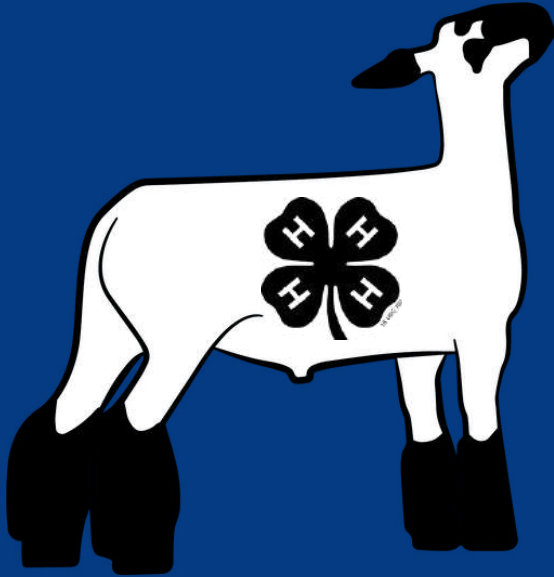
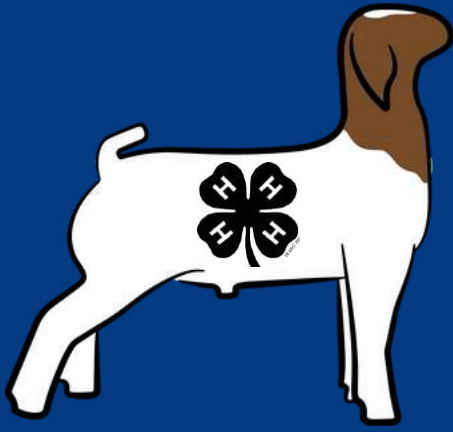

- 2 If you are selected, your pig will be purchased, processed, and delivered to a local pantry in your community.

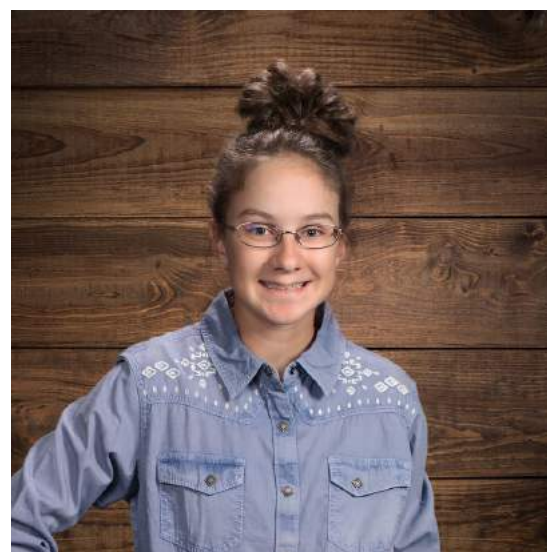
