

Turkey shoot contest and gun raffle to be held Nov. 13

For a couple years, the 4-H shooting sports leaders have not held a turkey shoot contest, but it's back again. On Sunday, November 13, Savory Savers Shooting Sports will hold target shooting contests for various ages and various calibers of rifles, all with the opportunity to win frozen turkeys as prizes. Shotgun contests and varmint rifle shoot offs will be held as well. It will be held at the trap club near Dixon, Wyo., beginning at 10:00 a.m.

The members of 4-H shotgun and rifle projects are also holding a raffle, with six rifles to be won. The proceeds will fund the supplies for the projects, including shotgun pigeons and shells, targets and

bullets, which saves parents money and makes it much easier for all kids to participate.

Tickets can be purchased from shotgun and rifle members and leaders, as well as the Stage Stop, Snake River Processing, and the Cowboy Inn. They cost \$20 per ticket or three tickets for \$50. For more information contact 4-H leaders O.R. and Jared Wille and Billy and Clay Orchard.

The raffle will be held at noon on Sunday, November 13, during the turkey shoot. The first drawn winner will receive a Ruger model 77 .300 Win. Mag. The second drawn will receive a Delta AR-15 .223. The third winner gets a Benelli Nova 12-gauge pump shotgun. Fourth is a Ruger 10-22 Target Lite. A Henry .22 lever action rifle will go to

the fifth drawn ticket. Finally, the sixth drawn will receive a Stoeger 3000 12-gauge pump shotgun.

Concessions will also be sold. Make plans to enjoy a fun day of friendly competition and prizes fit for the upcoming

Thanksgiving holiday, as well as the opportunity to support youth shooting. Buy tickets for the chance to obtain a new gun.


