

Who can apply? To qualify for consideration, you must:



Be a graduating senior and resident of Colorado, New Mexico, Utah or Wyoming



Be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States



Have an ACT score of 18+ in each category OR an SAT Math score of 490+ and Reading & Writing score of 490+



Have an unweighted GPA of 3.0+



Demonstrate financial need through Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$100,000 or less on the 2024 federal tax return on which the applicant is claimed as a dependent and review of other assets.
