Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Instructions

- Fill out the Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Application and return to the Converse County Extension Office. The application should be typed using a computer or a typewriter.
- The Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarship is for past Converse County 4-H members that have achieved completion or been awarded silver or gold levels of membership for a minimum of three years, and are currently enrolled and attending a college, university, or trade school.
- You must write a thank you note to the Converse County 4-H Foundation after receiving the scholarship. Thank you notes are to be sent to the Extension Office.
- If this is your first year applying for the Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarship please attach a photograph of yourself with your application.
- Scholarships are due the second Friday of January by 5:00pm. Late applications will not be
 accepted. If mailing your application plan on mailing 3-5 days before the deadline to ensure it
 will reach the office on time.
- Please sign and date your scholarship applications.
- You may apply for the Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarship once a year for every year
 that you are in school. If you fail to write the Converse County 4-H Foundation a thank you note,
 you will be ineligible for future Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarships.
- The Converse County 4-H Foundation Scholarship is a variable amount determined each year by funding. If you apply two years in a row, you might not get the same amount every year.
- If you have questions please contact the Converse County Extension Office at (307) 358-2417. Please note that the office is generally closed between Christmas and New Years so plan accordingly. Mailed applications must be postmarked <u>before</u> the due date.
