Enrollment Begins!

Wyoming 4-H has "open enrollment" meaning you can enroll in the program at any time. It is highly suggested you enroll as close to October 1st as possible to take advantage of all the fall activities. Also, different projects and events (animal projects, shooting sports projects, Self-Determined, Junior Leader Project, event registration, etc.) have different enrollment deadlines, so check with the 4-H Office if you have questions about specific projects.

University of Wyoming 4-H uses a software program called 4-HOnline for their data management and online payment of enrollment fees. Whether you are a parent enrolling your children, or an adult wishing to volunteer, it all starts by enrolling at 4-H Online (https://wy.4honline.com).

There is a \$10 fee for enrollment in Converse County 4-H. This fee covers the cost of insurance. All 4-H members and leaders are covered by Wyoming 4-H Insurance during 4-H functions.



Youth Leadership Project

The 4-H youth leadership experience is designed to provide members with the opportunity to learn about the qualities and competencies needed to be a leader. Junior leaders provide assistance, while teen leaders assume more challenging leadership roles.

The primary duties of a junior or teen leader are (varies by age, experience, and other factors):

- Work collaboratively with the adult leader to set goals, develop lesson plans, teach skills, and evaluate activities.
- Coordinate logistical details such as meeting times, locations, materials, supplies, and expenses with the adult leader.
- Communicate with the adult leader and members about group expectations, responsibilities and expected outcomes.

If you are 13-18 years of age, please consider becoming a CC4-H Junior Leader!
