The Converse County Fair Board with the information we have received from the health department, has made the decision to proceed with the 4H and FFA shows. The evening community events will be on hold pending the health departments guidance in July. We will follow the guidance of the health department as Covid-19 restrictions are lifted. As information develops, we will adjust the plan. For now, we are going to focus on making sure we put all our efforts towards ensuring that the 4H and FFA youth events are organized and comply with the health department restrictions. This could include changes to all of the shows and market sale. We are looking at technology to assist in the social distancing and group size restrictions, but plan to organize the shows as close to normal on the grounds of the WSF.
