Goals

- 1. Deliver high-quality information to your audience
- 2. For the audience to learn and apply information that solves a problem
 - Engaging
 - o Relevant
 - o Shorter
 - o Diverse
 - Make connections

#1: Be energetic!

- If you care, they care
- Show enthusiasm
 - Monotony is boring
- Be charismatic
- Act as if you're telling a story
 - Watch stand-up comedy and storytellers

#2: Show your face

- Creates a real human connection
- Engagement goes up by 70% when your video is on!
- Stand up (if possible)
 - o See body language, gestures, etc.
 - o What you say seems more important while you stand versus sitting down

#3: Diversify

- When recording many videos, try to vary your location
 - o New backgrounds create renewed engagement
 - o Different locations can create relevancy
 - Ex. coaching and mentoring could be filmed in the football stadium
 - Ex. raising pigs could be filmed on a farm

- Vary your outfits
 - o Your outfit should fit the topic and location
- Vary your content
 - o More than just a PPT and webcam
 - o Include brief interviews with other people
 - Include video clips
 - o Include how-to demonstrations

#4: Create relevancy

- Use real-life examples
- Share your own experiences and stories as an expert
- Incorporate real photos, images, and video
- Use outsides resources
 - You don't have to re-invent the wheel

#5: Keep it short

- An audience will disengage within 6-8 minutes on average
- Lecture/Content videos should ideally be no longer than 10-15 minutes
 - o Break larger content into multiple smaller videos

#6: Create a roadmap to success

- Let your audience know what you will be sharing in your video
 - State the learning objectives
- Keep things simple and easy to follow
- Make sure they know who to contact and where to find additional resources and information

Tips for success

- Rehearse and practice don't just wing it
- Make sure your audience knows where to find your information
- Add some humor
- Don't make the words move on PPT slides
- Creating quality content videos takes time expect it
- Ensure your content video is useful
 - o How-to videos are very effective
