The State of Wyoming, University of Wyoming, and its related 4-H program ensures safe learning environments through statutes, polices, and operational procedures that apply to 4-H volunteers. The following reference indicate some of them:

- Wyoming State Statute (14-3-205)
 - Title 14 requires any person who has reasonable cause to believe or suspect a child has been abused or neglected or observes conditions that may result in abuse or neglect to make a report to law enforcement or the Wyoming Department of Family Services (DFS).
