

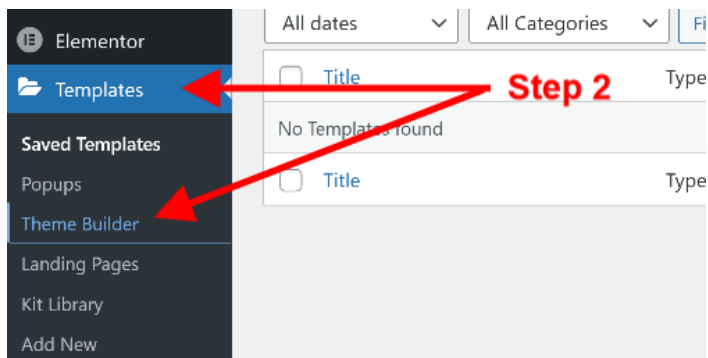

WordPress Guide: Adding Banner Images to Your Website

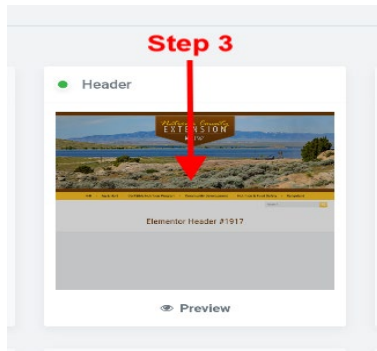
Adding a Main or Fallback Banner Image to the Entire Website

Step 1: Login to you WordPress website.

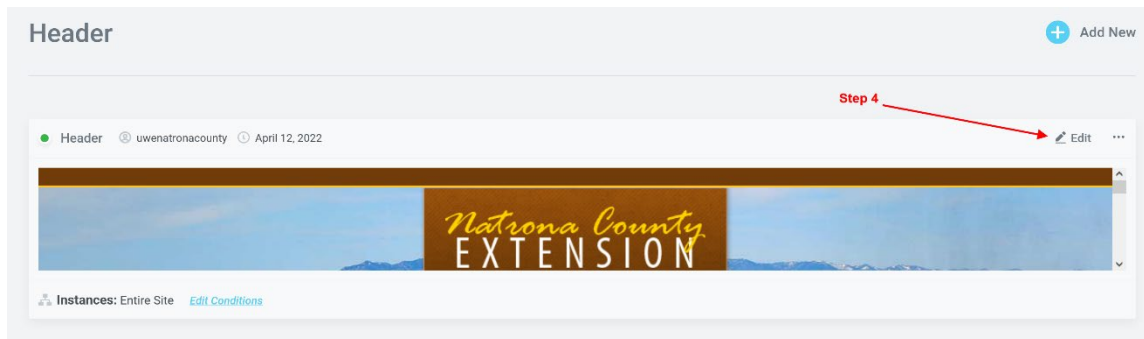
Step 2: Click “Templates” and select “Theme Builder” from the dropdown menu.



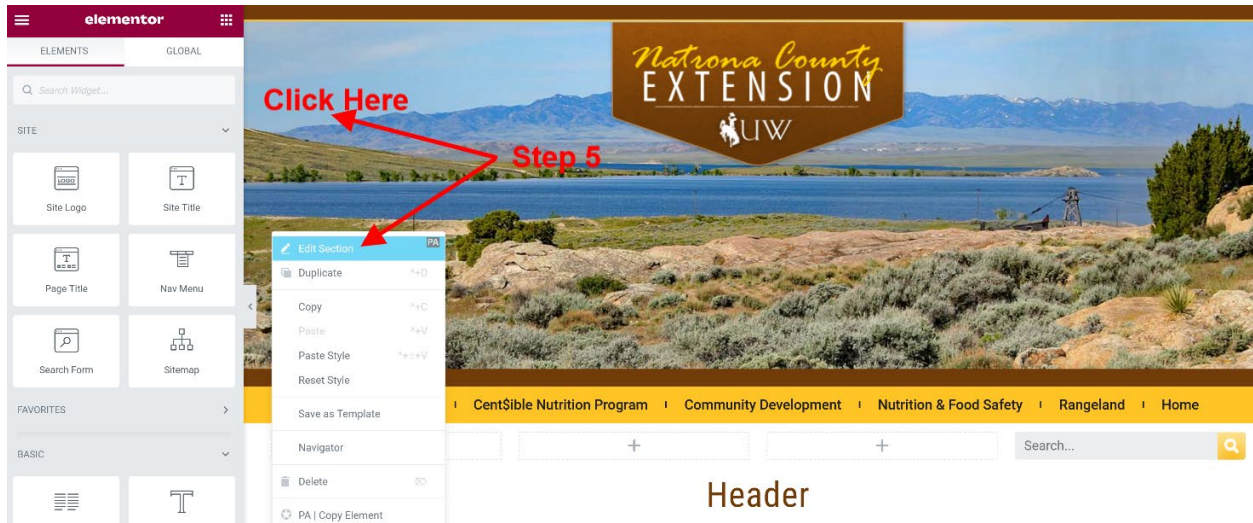
Step 3: Click “Header”.



Step 4: Click “Edit” in the upper right corner.



Step 5: Right Click on the banner image and select “Edit Section” from the popup.



Step 6: Select “Style” and click the “Featured Image”. Click the image under “Fallback”. The “Fallback” image will display on all pages as the banner image unless a “Featured Image” has been added to a page. Select an image from the Media Library or upload a new image. Suggested size: 2000 x 400 pixels.



Step 7: Click “Update”.

Adding a Banner Image to an Individual Webpage

Step 1: Select a webpage to “Edit” or add a new webpage. Do not click the “Edit with Elementor”.

Step 2: Scroll down until you see the “Featured Image” box on the right side.

Step 3: Click “Set Featured Image”. Select an existing image from the Media Library or upload a new image. The “Featured Image” will override the existing Fallback image. To display the Fallback image, simply remove the “The Featured Image”. Suggested size 2000 x 400 pixels.

Step 4: Click “Update”.
