The 2025 Wyoming Ranch Camp will be held at the Ladder Ranch in Carbon County, WY. WRC is a five-day camp covering all aspects of ranch management. Including, plant science & ecology, soil and animal science, economics, ranch recreation, and range management. Participants spend the week learning and developing their own ranch plan tailored to the host ranch.

Courses are taught by UW Extension personnel and local producers.
