



JOHNSON COUNTY 4-H COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility:

- Current Johnson County 4-H member in good standing.
- Minimum of five consecutive years in 4-H immediately preceding application. (8th-12th grade)
- Completed and submitted 4-H portfolio by due date for the previous 5 years.
- Graduating high school senior planning to attend an institute of higher learning/career program (ex. Apprenticeship) within 2 years of graduation.

Number and Amount of Scholarships:

- Multiple scholarships in variable amounts up to \$1000 will be awarded.

Selection will be based on the following:

- Application/ Record Book
- Community Service
- Leadership
- Overall 4-H involvement
- Interview with scholarship committee

Additional Information:

- Proof of registration and acceptance at an accredited institute of higher learning or program must be submitted to the Johnson County 4-H Council upon enrollment.
- One-half of the scholarship will be paid to the institution of the recipient's choice at the beginning of the first semester enrolled, upon receipt of proof of enrollment.
- Second half is to be paid at the beginning of second semester, upon receipt of proof of enrollment and that recipient is still a student in good standing.

What to Include with Application:

- Application must be completed and returned to the Johnson County Extension Office by April 1.
- 4-H portfolio must accompany the application in order for the committee to assess level of activity and participation in 4-H.
- Cumulative pages from the 4-H portfolio with information from the previous 5 years should be attached to application. This includes: 4-H Leadership, 4-H Community Service, 4-H Participation, Other Participation.
