How to fill out and use this certificate:

- 1. Fill out the form completely
- 2. Check to make sure all information is correct and that all necessary signatures are included
- 3. Submit to the Extension Office by May 1st. No exceptions

Members shall own or lease horses used in the 4-H/FFA Horse Project. Any 4-H/FFA horse must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Owned Horse: An owned horse should be identified by a Horse I.D. certificate. Required certificates shall be completed and returned to the local Extension Office by **May 1 of the current year.**
- 2. Leased Horse: Any leased horse is to be leased for one full year and must be leased prior to May 1 of the current year.
 - a. A Horse ID Certificate must be completed and returned to the office by May 1 of the current year.
 - b. The leased horse agreement below must be completed and notarized.
- 3. Whenever a question about horse identification arises, the 4-H/FFA member, as well as the member's county office share the responsibility to provide proper ownership proof.
- 4. Any infractions as determined by a county grievance review committee or county horse committee will disqualify said horse during the contract year for showing or competing in any county or state 4-H contest.
- 5. A 4-H/FFA member can lease one horse if he already owns a horse.
- 6. A 4-H/FFA member cannot lease more than one horse under any circumstances.
- 7. Multiple use horses: each horse must be identified by only one member. No other member can share any one horse with another 4-H or FFA member.
- 8. The deadline for ownership of an owned or leased horse is May 1.
