If you are wanting to be on the Livestock Judging team at State Fair you must participate in 2 of the 3 county practices and the county contest held during county fair.

#### **COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS**

In order for a 4-H member to complete each 4-H project taken, the 4-H member must enter at least one exhibit per project at the Niobrara County Fair (or other approved public event). The Junior Leader project is an exception to this rule. Each member must also submit a **COMPLETED** Record Book for each project taken and a Record Book folder. If each of the member's Record Books does not receive at least a red ribbon, their County Fair premiums will be forfeited. The folder includes: a Cover; the appropriate record books; the 4-H Portfolio; and a 4-H Story. Record Books are due in the Extension Office mid-September every year (the date changes slightly each year due to the calendar). **All Record Books of every 4-H member WILL be judged.** 

**Members must also attend at least one county wide judging in their respective project area**. For example, livestock project members a livestock judging and horse members a horse judging. Family & Consumer Science members must participate in at least one county Family & Consumer Science Activity Day to complete their project.

Instated in 2018, ALL members enrolled in a livestock project are also required to attend at least one of the several Educational Opportunities offered throughout the year - in addition to the one required livestock judging.







## **Cloverbud Activity**

## **Build A Bridge**

## Supplies: Set Up:

- Straws
- Plastic Cups
- Masking Tape

- Marbles
- Or use your imagination
- 1. Design and build a bridge that is capable of holding a plastic cup
- 2. See how many marbles your bridge will your bridge support

#### QUESTIONS TO ASK?

- What happens if....?
- Can you think of another way to try that?
- How could we make this idea even better?
- What ideas have we talked about that you haven't tried yet?

Bridges have been built for centuries utilizing many different designs, but they all have one thing in common. In order to not fall down, the bridge must balance two different kinds of force: compression (a pushing or squeezing force, acting inward) and tension (a pulling or stretching force, acting outward). By balancing these forces, bridges channel the weight or load of the bridge onto the main supports. By balancing these two forces there is no overall force to cause motion and do damage.

So how do you know which style bridge to build? There are lots of factors to consider, but the main one is how far the bridge needs to stretch. A very short span, such as over a small river, would likely use a beam or truss bridge. While a suspension or cable-stayed bridge could be used, they are more complex and expensive, and would require much more support than would be needed.

- 1. Peel bananas and break into pieces
- 2. Put in Ziploc bag and freeze overnight
