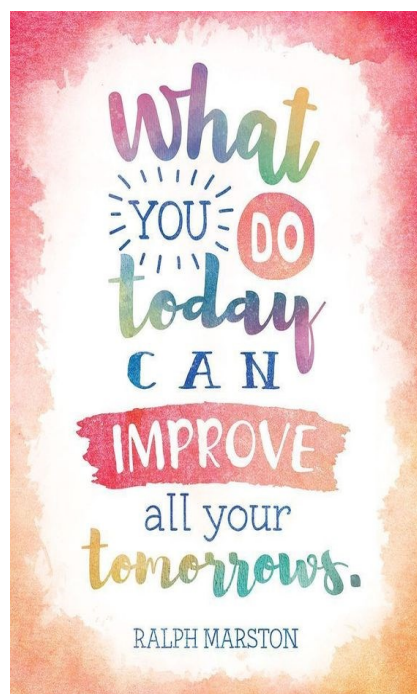

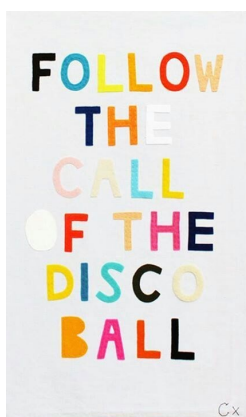

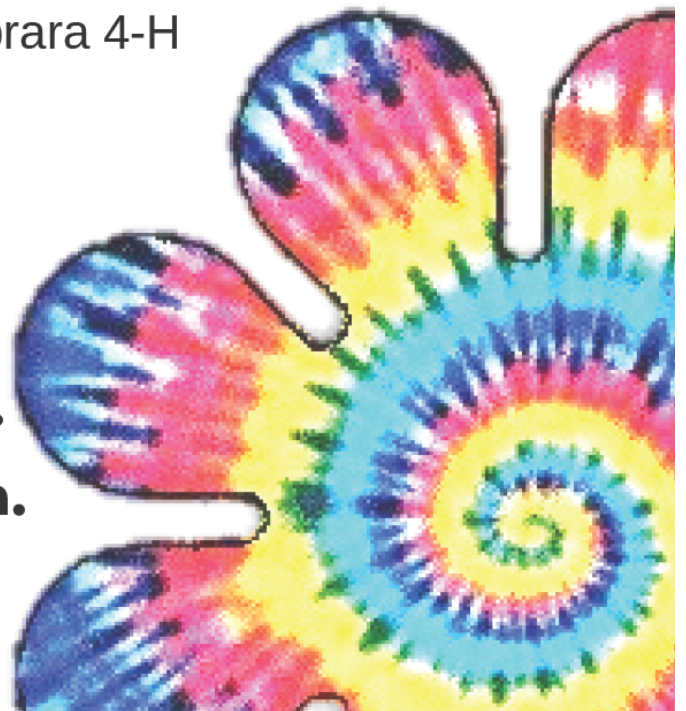

Market Steers	Minimum: 1150 lbs.	Maximum: 1400 lbs.
Market Heifers	Minimum: 1050 lbs.	Maximum: 1400 lbs.
Market Lambs	Minimum: 110 lbs.	Maximum: 150 lbs.
Market Swine	Minimum: 220 lbs.	Maximum: 285 lbs.
Market Goats	Minimum: 50 lbs.	

Cloverbud Activity

Sponge Bullseye

This activity is a great way to beat the heat of Summer. With just a few cheap materials, kids will be entertained all morning long. Best of all, you can practice some math skills while the kids have fun in the sun!

Here's what you need to make one:

- Sponges
- Sidewalk chalk

Step 1: Draw circles with the chalk to create a bullseye shape. You can use different colored chalk to make it more fun.

Step 2: Assign each circle points for scoring.

Step 3: Toss the sponges and try to get a bullseye. Add up the scores to practice math skills!

Jello Shaved Ice

Ingredients:

- 1 cup boiling water
- 2 cups Sprite or similar soda pop
- 1—four serving size any flavor Jello

Into a square cake pan, whisk the Jello into the boiling water until dissolved. Stir in the soda pop. Freeze for at least 4 hours or overnight. Use an ice cream scoop to shave the ice. Serve immediately.

- 1 package M&Ms

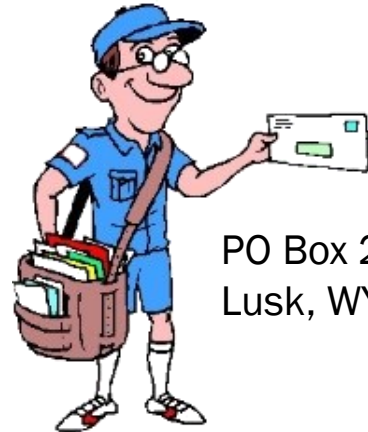
Mix all ingredients together. Scoop into individual bags or store in a closed container.
