



4-H Beef Project

The 4-H beef project allows youth to learn about breeds, selection, grooming, production, management, showmanship, marketing and careers through a breeding or market animal. As you select your market beef project, keep in mind your end goal. Select a project animal that will be big enough to meet the minimum weight at fair, 1150 pounds for steers and 1050 pounds for heifers. If you are going to have a market heifer project, you heifer will need to be spayed. You will need to provide a letter or certificate from your veterinarian. Work to set your goals now for your project learning.

Some examples for a junior member may include:

Proper feeding of your market project – how many pounds of grain and hay are you feeding, what percent protein is your feed?

Identify how a healthy calf looks and acts.

Halter break your animal and work with it to lead and eventually set up its feet with a showstick.

Intermediate member example goals may include:

Identify livestock safety hazards.

Explore a ruminant digestive system.

Identify common parasites and when and how to treat for them.

Senior member example goals may include:

Balance a beef ration.pro

Learn about Expected Progeny Differences (EPDs).

Start a livestock skill-a-thon team.

Lead a beef grooming and showmanship clinic for other members.
