Prepared Presentation Time Limits:

Juniors—3-10 minutes

Intermediates—5-10 minutes

Seniors—7-15 minutes

Presentations are judged on knowledge of subject matter, presentation manner and impact.

Impromptu Presentation Time Limits:

Juniors—Up to 3 minutes

Intermediates—2 1/2—4 minutes

Seniors—3-5 minutes

Impromptu Presentations emphasizes the need to think clearly and effectively on a topic with a short amount of preparation time.

Niobrara County Born and Raised Market Animal Contest


