Shooting Sports Fair Exhibits

All shooting sports members are required to have an indoor exhibit at the Niobrara County Fair. You are only limited by your imagination. You can draw, paint, built, photograph, etc. These will be evaluated by age. Contact one of the Shooting Sports Leaders or the Extension Office if you have any questions. Each exhibit will need a skill sheet with it, which you can pick up at the Extension Office. This is just a way to explain what you did, why and what you learned completing your project. The exhibits will be due on August 4th before 9:00 AM

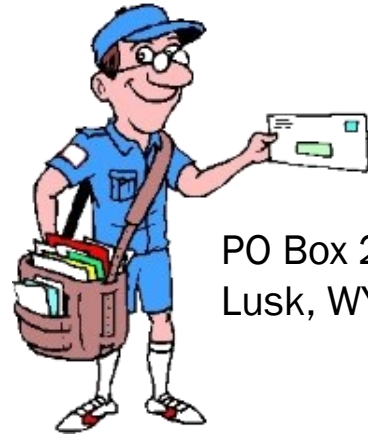
Niobrara County Born and Raised Market Animal Contest
