We will be having a party to send her into retirement on March 25. More details will be forthcoming, so keep an eye out for those. We would love to have you here.



Forms can be picked up at the Extension Office Breeding beef and sheep will need to attach a brand inspection or registration papers in the exhibitor's name. Breeding goats and swine will just need to submit the ID form. Any animals not identified by June 1, 2022 will not be eligible to exhibit. Contact Kellie if you have any questions.


