

Niobrara County Homemakers  
Council Scholarship

Must be postmarked by April 1

- There are three scholarships available for \$750.00 each from two out of the three following categories:
- A scholarship available to anyone pursuing any college or trade school degree.
- The traditional student-must be pursuing full time study in any college or trade school, must be within 4 years of high school graduation and have graduated high school with a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- The non-traditional student-must be returning to school more than 4 years past high school graduation, and may be pursuing any college course of study or trade school, taking six or more credit hours.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be a Niobrara County resident OR
2. Reside in the Niobrara County School District OR
3. A graduate of Niobrara County High School OR
4. Any person who has obtained a GED and resides in Niobrara County OR
5. Any person that is pursuing a college or trade school degree that has a relative that belongs to a Niobrara County Homemakers Club.

A traditional student must be a full time college student who has a cumulative grade average of 2.5 or higher.

A present year graduate may apply, but the funds will be granted only upon proof of college enrollment. It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit proof of enrollment to the chairwoman of the scholarship committee; once received the scholarship funds will be awarded.

Scholarship can be used at the institution of choice of the applicant.

- Letter stating desire, reason for wanting this scholarship and long-term goals.
- Answer two (2) of the questions from the question sheet and state the question
- Transcript from the institution that you are currently attending (unofficial will be accepted).
- References (optional)
