



Please give it every consideration



MOVING FIREWOOD CAN TRANSPORT FOREST INSECTS AND DISEASES.



Tree-killing pests hitchhike on firewood spreading insects and diseases that destroy our street trees, forests and natural areas.

Protect your favorite places from this threat:

- Buy locally harvested firewood, or certified heat treated firewood.
- Ask a park ranger or campground host about where to get local firewood when you travel.
- Use firewood from nearby sources to heat your home or cabin.
- Tell your friends not to move firewood.





Infestations of invasive insects and diseases can kill tens of thousands of trees in just a few years.

Prevention is the key. Don't move firewood when you travel, camp, or visit another state.

Keep your backyard, campgrounds, and favorite places safe from these insects and diseases. Buy firewood near where you will burn it. If you are unsure of an insect or disease consult a professional arborist or contact a University of Wyoming Extension.

Expands 'pool of resources'... increased manpower


Increases the number of 'work' hours to address questions and/or make yard calls
