PURPOSE

WLI increases the capacity of individuals to lead with confidence.

OBJECTIVES

- Provide training in leadership concepts and techniques.
- Enhance understanding of issues, economics, diversity and resources.
- Build relationships between people and communities.
- Prepare and motivate participants for greater community involvement.

WLI is open to emerging and established leaders who wish to increase their leadership skills, knowledge and participation in the community. The Institute consists of eight full day sessions and is a mix of educational and participatory experiences.

Tuition is \$250 and \$200 for each additional participant from the same organization. Tuition includes instruction, materials and meals. Full or partial scholarships are available. Attendance is required for the first session and is expected at all other sessions. Class size will be limited to 25 participants. Selection of participants will be based on criteria specified on the application form. College credit is available.
