4-H Age is determined by your child's age as of January 1, 2026.

Cloverbuds are 5-7 years old as of January 1

Junior 4-H members are 8-10 years old as of January 1

Intermediate 4-H members are 11-13 years old as of

January 1

Senior 4-H members are 14-18 years old as of January 1
