 - o Went through the fair book by sections and Superintendents made recommendations on changes for their sections. There was only one item that had action taken on it. That was the following:
 - Page 8 number 16 of the current fair book clarification of ownership. Now it reads as follows: Ownership- All Livestock must be owned by the sole-member (100%) by the following Dates.
 - February 1st market beef, May 1st dog ID, June 1st breeding beef, sheep, swine, rabbit, dairy goats, market goats, dairy cattle, poultry, and pocket pets.
 - o Proof of Ownership is determined by the following:
 - For the livestock requiring brand inspections, the 4-H/FFA
 member exhibiting the animal must be the only name on the brand
 inspection. All other animals must have proof that the member is
 sole owner via bill of sale or other legal documentation.
 - Susie motioned to make the change Lacey 2nd.
 - Tony amended the motion that we only implement the Proof of Ownership for the animals that require brand inspections and table the other species until the February meeting. Stewart 2nd the motion.
 - The original motion and amended motion both passed unanimously.

- New Business:
 - o Fairgrounds Report (Kimber)
 - Susie Terry was re-appointed to the fair board.
 - If you have any changes or projects for the fairgrounds staff, please get those to Kimber and Chris by the 2/5/25 Livestock Committee Meeting.
 - They completed multiple projects this winter: New dog show panels, modified the sheep pens, rebuilt the rabbit show table, rebuilt and painted the chicken pens.
 - Working on a Petting Zoo for the County Fair.
 - The new holding pens for the show ring will be delivered on 2/9/25.

Chris motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:37pm and Lacey 2nd. Meeting adjourned.
