Resume

Include skills and abilities, prior work experience, education, references and leadership experiences on your resume. This is the exact same as a resume you would turn in when applying for a job.

However, this is a 4-H scholarship application, so you will also need to include all the activities, awards, clubs, clinics, domestic and foreign trips, leadership experiences, fairs and community service projects you've participated in through 4-H.

Put these experiences in a comprehensive list that is neat and easily readable.

This will take some time to write down but it could be the difference in you receiving a scholarship or not.

List all of it! We want to know!

General Knowledge

Read and answer all the application questions thoroughly

Brag about yourself when answering the questions

Reread your application answers to ensure there are no grammar or spelling mistakes and that your answers make sense

Turn in your application in on time

Be authentic, unique and descriptive when answering the questions
