Traveling for 4-H Activities and Events

The next few months are full of awesome 4-H activities and events, so it is really important to remember to travel safely to and from all of those fun events! Wyoming 4-H requires that to transport youth other than your own children that you are an official 4-H Volunteer and that you have completed the Motor Vehicle Check (MVR). This is to protect the youth and volunteers by complying with UW Risk Management and Insurance.

WHAT THE HECK IS AN MVR?

MOTOR VEHICLE RECORDS CHECK

If you are planning on providing transportation of youth in the 4-H program you must complete the MVR. 4-H is a program of the University of Wyoming and anytime you transport 4-H members you are driving on University business. UW policy requires individuals who drive on University business to complete the MVR check annually. This applies to all driving, whether doing so in a personal, rental, county vehicle or UW vehicle.

The motor vehicle record (MVR) check is completed by the UW Department of Risk Management. The MVR includes moving violations and at fault accidents in the past 12 months and any major convictions in the past 36 months. A flagged MVR check may result in restrictions to the 4-H volunteer leaders' approval to transport 4-H members who are not their own children.


Objectives







Chapter 26 Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza Mitigation Rules

Wyoming Livestock Board Emergency Rule



This rule does state "For the duration of these emergency rules, all poultry events, including exhibitions, swaps, tours, sales, and competitions, are prohibited. This prohibition does not include catalog or retail sale of poultry." The rule is required by statute to state 120 days. The State Veterinarian and team will review the rule in late May to determine if it may be canceled prior to 120 days, keeping county and state poultry shows intact County Fair and 4-H are preparing options if the shows are infact cancelled, but for now, please know nothing is set in stone.
