- Success in leadership roles in local, state, or national organizations or government

• A community member, business or group who shows obvious and exceptional support for the Weston County 4-H program

- Works hard to show a spirit for the 4-H's: head, heart, hands and health
- Works hard to learn and grow through 4-H activities

- Willingness to take on leadership and volunteer roles
- Shares 4-H spirit and excitement with others
